Renal replacement therapies may not be widely available in veterinary medicine yet, but have been found to be beneficial in managing acute and chronic kidney injury in veterinary patients. This lecture will review different modalities including hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis, and therapeutic plasma exchange. We will focus on how each modality works and which disease processes may be treated with extracorporeal therapy.

Breaking Up With Breaking Down- IMHA | Marlaina Hrosch

Immune mediated hemolytic anemia is a life threatening disease in small animals where red blood cells are being destroyed by the immune system. This lecture will review the pathophysiology behind this disease to better understand why patients often exhibit certain vital signs and diagnostic abnormalities on presentation. We will also review some of the treatment options available as well as nursing considerations when caring for IMHA patients.
